Rationale

Purpose

Guidelines

Purpose

- To gain control over our energy consumption by monitoring and improving our energy use practices.

Implementation

1. Staff will be encouraged to appoint 'Student Energy Managers' within each classroom.
2. Energy use within the school will be regularly monitored.
3. The school will be actively involved in the implementation of Energy Smart strategies.
4. Implementation is based on the following recommendations
 - Recommended room temperature settings are between 19-21 degrees.
 - Natural ventilation should be used as often as required.
5. Classroom displays can be used to remind students of energy saving ideas.

Evaluation

The program will be monitored by staff and students who will inform the Principal of any action needed to be taken.
