



## Uniform

### Rationale

- To create a sense of collective and individual pride in being part of the school.
- To assure individual student's safety and group security at all times, especially when on school excursions.
- To provide the avenue for students to be adequately and economically dressed without undue competition in the areas of fashion, style and status.

### Purpose

At Bellbrae Primary School we believe that all students should wear the Bellbrae Primary School uniform:

- **Red** and **green** the predominant colours.
- White trimming acceptable.(logo and socks)
- Items can be with or without the school logo.

### Guidelines

1. All children from Prep – 6 will wear the Bellbrae Primary School uniform in line with D.E.T. policy. Refer to the Victorian Government Schools Reference Guide Section 4.8 Student Dress Code.
2. All uniform items should be reasonably priced, of suitable quality, appropriate for school activities and offer a range of choices.
3. The school council will ratify a list of uniform items and will regularly monitor any inclusions or exclusions from this list. (uniform list in Program Implementation, Point 9).
4. The Bellbrae Primary School uniform (new and second hand) will be available for purchase/order through the school's office.
5. Uniform items may be purchased from other retail outlets.
6. Any changes to the School Uniform Policy will be made through School Council.

## Purpose

All students at Bellbrae Primary School should wear the Bellbrae Primary School uniform.

## Implementation

1. The wearing of our school uniform is compulsory.
2. Uniform items can be purchased at various retailers.
3. Any alterations to the uniform list will be made through School Council.
4. All students will wear the school broad brimmed sun hats during Term 1 and Term 4, unless notified otherwise. (Refer to the Sunsmart Policy.)
5. The only form of earrings permitted for students, are studs and sleepers.
6. All teachers will monitor student's school uniform. Teachers will remind students and use school diaries and letters to reinforce the uniform policy throughout the school. Consideration will be given to all circumstances.
7. Children who are consistently out of uniform will be brought to the attention of the Principal, who will consider all circumstances and liaise with the family.
8. As part of the implementation, a uniform 'shop' co-ordinator(s) will be appointed and will be responsible for
  - monitoring prices
  - monitoring quality,
  - availability of items,
  - advertising items in newsletter,
  - collating and distributing orders
9. **THE BELLBRAE PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM**  
**RED** and **GREEN** are the predominate colours.

### Bottoms

Track Pants (red or green)

Gabardine pants (red or green)

### Girls:

Gingham School Dress (red or green)
