We are all feeling a strong sense of loss after the passing of Brendan Beattie, our school IT technician. Brendan was a warm, gentle, compassionate, witty and humorous staff member who loved connecting with everyone he met. He was incredibly dedicated to his role and regularly worked on additional projects for the school because he enjoyed solving problems and helping others. He worked at numerous schools in the Barwon area including Winchelsea, Anglesea and Moriac Primary Schools. He had a sudden illness, and his death has shocked us, as we all just expected to see him waltz back in at some stage next term and setting our day up with a random joke. We shared the news with students yesterday to ensure the message was consistent. If your child requires additional support, please do not hesitate in reaching out. The funeral arrangements have been made and will not impact our daily operations - please contact the office if you would like the details. We whole-heartedly pass on our condolences to Brendan's family, and particularly his mother Bernice and son Nathan. Rest in peace mate.



On a more cheerful note, our Foundation to Year 4 students will be participating in our Swimming Safety Program for the final two weeks of the term. We are pleased with the uptake and acknowledgement of the importance of water safety within our community. It is not only about personal safety, but the safety of those around us.

Today, our Year 5 students returned from their three-day camp to Sovereign Hill. We would like to thank Mr Reid, Mrs Virgona, Mr Bowen, Phil, Camryn, Jacob and other supporting staff for their leadership on the camp. The skills, knowledge and understanding developed through our camps and excursions programs are invaluable to the development of our students.

Our 2025 Foundation and whole school transition dates have been scheduled for Thursday 7 November 9:15-11AM, Wednesday 27 November and Tuesday 10 Dec 9:15AM to 1:40PM. If parents are yet to enrol Foundation students, we urge you to do so immediately. In addition, if any families are moving away from Bellbrae PS next year, we would appreciate notice as it will support us to adequately prepare for 2025.

Over the past few weeks, we have had staff visit Grovedale PS and Surf Coast Secondary College to observe numeracy and literacy teaching in their environments. It has allowed us to reflect on our practices in reducing cognitive load for students and supporting them to transition more effectively. We will continue to leverage such opportunities for professional learning.

On Monday 26 August 2024, an amendment to the Fair Work Legislation Amendment (Closing Loopholes) Act 2023 came into effect. The new provisions will be adopted alongside the department's existing industrial and employment obligations, including occupational health and safety commitments. The legislation makes explicit that all employees have the right to refuse contact from their employer or a third party (such as a student or a parent) outside of their normal working hours, unless that refusal is unreasonable. This means an employee can refuse to monitor, read or respond to contact that occurs outside their normal working hours.

This aligns to our current practice of replying to urgent communications within 24 hours and general communication in 2-3 days. We would like to thank our community for the respectful manner in which you communicate with staff. It's another reason why we all love being part of the community.

Finally, we would like to remind everyone that term 3 concludes on Friday 20 September at 2:30PM. If you are unable to make the earlier pick-up, please book your child into Their Care's afternoon program in advance.

We thank you for supporting us through a busy term and if your AFL team is battling it out in the final - good luck!

Our programs



Baby College Pre-birth – Six months

Baby College brings together women who are pregnant in their third trimester or have a child less than six months old, to support them on their parenting journey. Baby College is open to women over 25 years and first-time pregnancy is not a requirement. The program aims to:

- Enhance parent and child attachment.
- Increase understanding of child development.



Bumps to Bubs Pre-birth – 12 months

Bumps to Bubs brings together young mothers and mothers-to-be up to age 23 or 25* (please refer to individual schedule) with babies zero to 12 months, to support them on their parenting journey. The program aims to:

- Bring young mothers and babies together for fun, learning and friendship in a relaxed setting.
- Enhance parent and child attachment.
- Increase understanding of child development.



Bubs to Tots 12 months – Two years

Bubs to Tots brings together mothers (up to 24 years old) of children in the 12 months to two years age group for support and education. The program aims to:

- Provide education to enhance children's early development.
- Promote parent and child attachment/relationships through the promotion of play.
- Assist parents with managing and enjoying the toddler years.



Tuning in to Kids Three years – 12 years

Tuning in to Kids is a six week supportive program for parents of children aged three to 12 years. The program aims to:

- Help parents teach their children to understand and manage their emotions.
- Support parents in encouraging children to express emotions appropriately.
- Maximise children's social, behavioural and learning outcomes.



Dads Tuning in to Kids Three years – 12 years

Dads Tuning in to Kids is a six week supportive program specifically for dads of children aged three to 12 years. The program aims to:

- Help dads to effectively tune in to their child's emotions.
- Encourage dads to strengthen their emotional connection with their child.
- Support dads to build skills in emotion coaching to assist their child's individual needs.



Tuning in to Teens 10 years – 18 years

Tuning in to Teens is a six week supportive program for parents of adolescents aged 10 years to 18 years. The program aims to:

- Support parents to connect and communicate with their teen.
- Assist parents with understanding adolescent development.
- Help parents to assist their teen to develop emotional intelligence.



Strengthening Family Connections Eight years – 12 years

Strengthening Family Connections is an eight week program for parents and their children aged eight to 12 years. The program aims to:

- Build a positive culture and improve communication among family members.
- Help develop successful, confident children and parents.
- Build skills in all family members to improve family functioning.



Bringing Up Great Kids - Parenting Adolescents 10 years – 18 years

Bringing Up Great Kids - Parenting Adolescents is a six week supportive program for parents of children aged 10 years to 18 years. The program aims to:

- Support parents to build a positive relationship with their adolescent.
- Help parents understand what is going on in the adolescent brain.
- Explore the changing role from custodian to consultant.



5 TIPS TO GET YOUR CHILD OFF THEIR EMOTIONAL ROLLERCOASTER:

1 CONNECT WITH YOUR CHILD

Use **empathy** to show their emotional outbursts don't make you love them any less.

"I can see that you're struggling right now, and I'm here for you. I love you."

2 HELP THEM UNDERSTAND HOW THEY ARE FEELING

Avoid **telling** them how they should feel about a situation. Instead, **help them understand how they are feeling**.

"I can see that your body is tense and you're breathing fast. It looks like you're feeling angry and frustrated."

3 BRAINSTORM IDEAS FOR DEALING WITH BIG EMOTIONS TOGETHER

Remind them of these ideas when they need them.

"Next time you feel this way, what would help? What could you tell yourself to help ride it out?"

4 TALK TO YOUR CHILD

Wait until they are in a more **emotionally stable place**. Then, **talk about their behaviors** and what they need to do differently.

"Remember when you were very angry yesterday? Let's talk about how I can help you next time you're feeling that way."

5 TEACH YOUR CHILD A "BIG EMOTIONS MANTRA":

Life is full of ups and downs, but they are all part of the journey!

My emotions are like big waves, and I can ride them out!

Emotions change, but love stays the same!

By actively helping your child learn to recognize, understand, and cope with emotional highs and lows, you'll prepare them for the roller coaster of life.



Technology (application) update: X Box live

Xbox LIVE is an online service used to access a library of games and music, download and play games and connect with friends through Microsoft's Xbox 360 console.



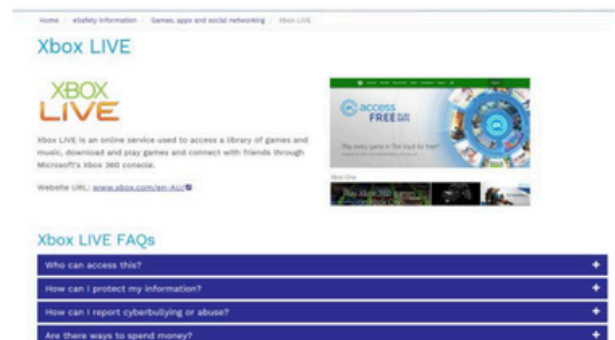

People of all ages can play Xbox live. If you are a child, your account is linked to an adult's Windows LIVE ID.



Xbox LIVE's default online safety and privacy settings are divided into three age groups: child (under 13), teen (13–18) and adult (over 18).



If you believe a player has violated the Xbox LIVE Code of Conduct, you can file a complaint two ways:

- visit the Reporting Abuse on Xbox LIVE page which has a step-by-step guide that outlines how to file a complaint through the Xbox Dashboard
- if the game has a complaint option, you can file a complaint within the game. Refer to the documentation that came with the game for instructions.

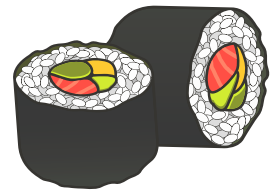

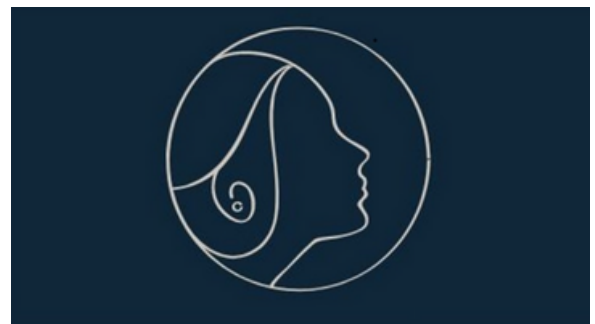
